

Camden Area Youth Seamanship Program, CAYSP

Code of Conduct

1. CAYSP students will remain with their class and instructors during their class times.
2. Each student is expected to arrive on time. Students arriving late MAY not be capable of joining their class after it has left the dock.
3. All students must wear and secure an USCG approved lifejacket at all times while on the CYC docks and in all CAYSP / CYC boats.
4. All students must wear shirts, closed-toe shoes and sun protection.
5. All students take responsibility for the care of CAYSP equipment and gear while on the water and on land. In addition, students must properly fold sails and store all equipment and personal property before leaving class.
6. All students will treat the members of the CAYSP community (students, instructors and parents) with kindness and respect.
7. Students may not use or possess any illegal or controlled substances (including alcohol) of any kind while participating in the CAYSP program.
8. All students are expected to act in a responsible manner and with integrity at all times while in CAYSP programming. Members of the CAYSP / CYC Racing Teams are representatives of the Camden Area Youth Seamanship Program and the Camden Yacht Club, and as such, whenever a team member goes to another club they are expected to emulate the ideals of safety, good sportsmanship and fair play.
9. CAYSP is responsible for our students during class hours, 8:30 - 11:30 and 1:00 - 4:00. During special events on-site at CYC (Bucket Race, Awards Night, etc.) parents are responsible for their children.
