

Dear Fellow Members and CYC Lunch Customers:

In a year full of, “Well, this is going to be different!”, I am writing to assure you that CYC will be serving lunch Monday through Saturday, 11:30AM – 2:00PM, beginning on June 22 and ending September 5. Mike Fisher is back and we expect great food at reasonable prices! And, yes, it’s going to be different in order to protect you, other members, guests, and staff from infection. But still, we need you to come down and use the lunch program, so that when things open up, we’ll be able to delight you as you’ve always been delighted by the terrific food and the magnificent location.

SUMMARY: Lunches will be ordered by telephone, packaged for takeaway, and picked up in the portico on the west side of the clubhouse. Because 50 people maximum will be allowed on the CYC grounds, we have designed the lunch program so that you can eat it at home, a favorite picnic area, on your boat, or at one of the few tables on the CYC lawn or porch. (Neither the clubhouse nor the kitchen will be open.)

MENU: The fixed menu will be chosen from among CYC favorites and will be posted on the CYC website and emailed to you each Monday morning. The email will highlight specials early in the week and the hostess will be able to answer questions about daily specials when you call to order. In addition, you will be able to purchase canned or bottled beverages.

ORDER: Our hostess for the last several years, Emily Long, will take your telephone-only orders at (207) 236-0281 from 10AM through 1:45PM on the day you wish to pick up your lunch. If her line is busy, it means she is taking another order. Please leave a message to be called back or call back in a few minutes. The lunch will be prepared for the time you desire, if possible. Your lunch will be charged to your account—Emily cannot make cash or credit-card transactions.

LUNCH: Everything you need for a satisfying takeaway experience will be included in the bag. You will be equipped as necessary with knives, forks, spoons, napkins, plates, bowls, cups (for the bottled and canned beverages), straws, and condiments. Hot items will be packaged separately from cold items.

PICK UP: A runner will deliver your lunch from the kitchen counter to a specially prepared table on the CYC porch next to the portico. The lunch will have your order ticket stapled to the bag and your name will be written in bold marker. You will drive up to the portico, get out of your car, take your lunch off the delivery table, get back in your car, and drive off leaving the portico empty for the next lunch customer. If there is a parking space and a free table, you can park and eat at CYC. If not, the cockpit of your boat or your porch may entice you.

TABLES: There will be seating for 44 people outside for lunch at CYC, the maximum allowed including others who will be at the club. Two picnic tables on the porch, two picnic tables on the lawn, and five round tables with four chairs, and four square tables with two chairs will be scattered about. Housemates may sit together; others must observe the current social distancing protocols—six feet of separation. Table and chairs will be sanitized each morning before lunch service begins. Members who use the tables and chairs are expected to clear and sanitize them after use. Please do not move the tables or the chairs.

PARKING: Parking is limited to one vehicle per space—there will be no tandem parking and staff will not be able to move double-parked cars.

RESTROOMS: The CYC bathrooms will be open for use. Appropriate signage will be placed on bathroom doors, including our general guidance policy language regarding operating under COVID and will also indicate:

1. Use limited to one-at-a-time to comply with social distancing.
2. Users responsible for cleaning up after themselves, with wipes and spray provided.
3. Bathrooms are cleaned every morning.
