- Follow the racing rules. Race committee will disqualify you if in violation.
- All yachts will tow an appropriate dinghy
- VHF Channel 65A
- Have Fun

Course

- Start between **R #2 Bell** off Curtis Island and the committee boat [Candace III, 40' black power boat] in a southerly direction.
- Leave **Mark Island** to port. Continue towards Oak I Passage.
- Leave **Burnt Island** to starboard. Head toward Deer I Thorofare.
- Leave **C"23"** by Billings Marine to starboard.
- Leave **Deer Isle** and the town of **Stonington** to port. Continue east
- Leave **Bell R"2"** at the eastern end of the Deer I Thorofare to port.
- Leave **N"2"** off Long Ledge to port.
- Leave **C "9"** off Green Ledge to port.
- Finally leave **C "5"** by Channel Rock to port.
- Proceed to the finish between Babson I and Naskeag Pt. marked by the committee boat to starboard and a dinghy with flag to port.

Start Times

	Boats 45 feet and over and all SOT		Boats under 45 feet
11:00	Warning signal – white flag	11:15	Preparatory signal – blue flag
11:05	Preparatory signal – blue flag	11:20	Start signal – red flag
11:10	Start signal – red flag		

- Boats starting early will be assessed a time penalty.
- Boats not towing a dinghy over the entire course will be assessed a penalty.

Provision for fog and/or lack of wind - If there is insufficient wind for a start at 11:15 there will be announcements on VHF channel 65A. Proceed under power along the race course and listen for the committee boat to issue new start instructions.

START #2 – East of Goose I - Between **C"3"** and the Committee boat
Start times will be announced on VHF channel 65A.

START #3 – East of Oak I - Between Dagger Ledge and the Committee boat.
Start times will be announced on VHF channel 65A.

NOTES:

1. Due to lack of wind or other weather conditions, the race may be ended early with an announcement on channel 65A. Billings Marine is a likely location for the new finish.
2. The race officially ends at 5:00 pm. After that time, the committee boat may leave the finish. Individual yachts may finish the race and report their own time to the committee boat on VHF channel 65A or abandon the race and proceed to Brooklin.
3. Please be aware that shore side access at Wooden Boat in Brooklin is prohibited. Please be respectful of this policy during this unprecedented time of global pandemic.
